

BEEF PEN SHOW

**Rules & Regulations
December 17th and 18th, 2021**

GENERAL RULES

1. A copy of a manifest will be required to be given to the Pen Show Committee for all commercial cattle and purebred bulls. Medicine Hat Exhibition and Stampede grounds Premise ID#AB337JU7D
2. All cattle must have a registered RFID tag.
3. All purebred registered or commercial animals, whether owned by one person or by more than one person (individually or jointly), which are maintained on one farm or breeding unit, are considered to be the production of one farm or breeding unit.
4. Purebred Breeders with commercial open heifers will be eligible to enter the Purebred Breeders - Commercial Open Heifer Class. Purebred Breeders are not eligible to enter cattle in any other Commercial classes.
5. The Pen Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any animals.
6. Commercial Cattle will be weighed and split by weight into two classes for the open heifer class.
7. The Pen Show Committee has the authority to check cattle for identification and has the authority to disqualify an entry.
8. A panel of three judges will judge all classes. Cattle will pass through the ring and be scored on an individual basis.
9. **Move in Times:** Cattle will be accepted in the Cypress Centre Pavilion & Fieldhouse on Thursday, December 16th from 12:00 pm to 9:00 pm and Friday, December 17th from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm.
10. **Weigh In Times:** Cattle will be weighed Friday, December 17th from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
11. **Move out Time:** no cattle will be released until the conclusion of the show on Saturday, December 18th.
12. Multiple pens will be allowed as space permits. Space is to be allocated to commercial and purebred cattle at the discretion of The Pen Show Committee. All entries will be accepted on a first come - first serve basis.
13. The Stampede Company will provide shavings for purebred pens and commercial classes. Supplies are limited, and the responsibility of all feed requirements falls to the exhibitor.
14. During all pen classes, both commercial and purebred, cattle must be released before entry to the show ring.
15. We encourage the entry of home raised cattle and thank you for your cooperation.
16. Exhibitors are responsible to comply with Alberta Liquor and Gaming Commission rules and regulations. Only the Medicine Hat Exhibition and Stampede is licensed to serve alcohol.
17. All animals tied in outside tie outs must also be tied with a neck rope
