Honourary Parade Marshall: BOB RIDLEY

Bob Ridley is the Medicine Hat Tigers longtime broadcaster who had missed only one game in 51 seasons of Tigers hockey before having to step back until the final game of the 2021-22 season due to cancer treatments. Ridley has called a game in every season of Tigers history and was set to reach the 4,000th game milestone in 2020 before COVID pushed his big game to March 21, 2021. The one time bus driver of the Tigers was honoured last season with a banner hung in Co-op Place. The

Western Hockey League has created an award in the 77-year-old's name, the Bob Ridley Award for Media Excellence, which is to be presented annually to a distinguished member of the radio, television, and print journalism industry in recognition of their outstanding contributions to sports journalism and the WHL. Ridley was the first recipient.




