Rules & Regulations

December 15th and 16th, 2023

ALL GENERAL RULES APPLY

4-H Heifer Show

- 1. Eligible Animals: Yearling heifers must be born in 2023. Bred heifers must be all born in 2022.
- 2. Cattle to be stalled in DESIGNATED AREA.
- 3. All cattle must have an approved RFID tag.
- 4. Clipping is allowed and all animals must be halter broke.
- 5. All animals must be a registered 4-H project
- 6. Cattle must be treated for internal and external parasites at least 3 weeks prior to show.
- 7. Cattle showing signs of unhealthiness (pneumonia, ringworm, etc.) will be disqualified.
- 8. No nose leads
- 9. An unmanageable animal that poses a safety or health risk shall shown and will be removed from the facility at the committee's discretion.
- 10. All entries must sign in at the show office prior to entering the show ring.

4-H Steer Show

- 1. Cattle to be stalled in DESIGNATED AREA.
- 2. All cattle must have an approved RFID tag.
- 3. Clipping is allowed and all animals must be halter broke.
- 4. All animals must be a registered 4-H project.
- 5. No nose leads
- 6. Cattle must be treated for internal and external parasites at least 3 weeks prior to show.
- 7. No intact males or signs of intact males will be allowed to show.
- 8. An unmanageable animal that poses a safety or health risk shall shown and will be removed from the facility at the committee's discretion.
- 9. Cattle showing signs of unhealthiness (pneumonia, ringworm etc.) will be disqualified.
- 10. All entries must sign in at the show office prior to entering the show ring.

Team Grooming

- 1. All animals used for team grooming must be halter broke.
- 2. Teams must be created and entered prior to the show.

- 3. Entries- team members are only allowed to compete once.
- 4. If teams are a mixed group of ages they will compete in group of the oldest member (Example: one intermediate and two juniors will compete in an intermediate class)
- 5. Teams are responsible for supplying their own animal to compete with.
- 6. Teams are responsible for supplying their own products for grooming.
- 7. Fitting chutes will be supplied.
