

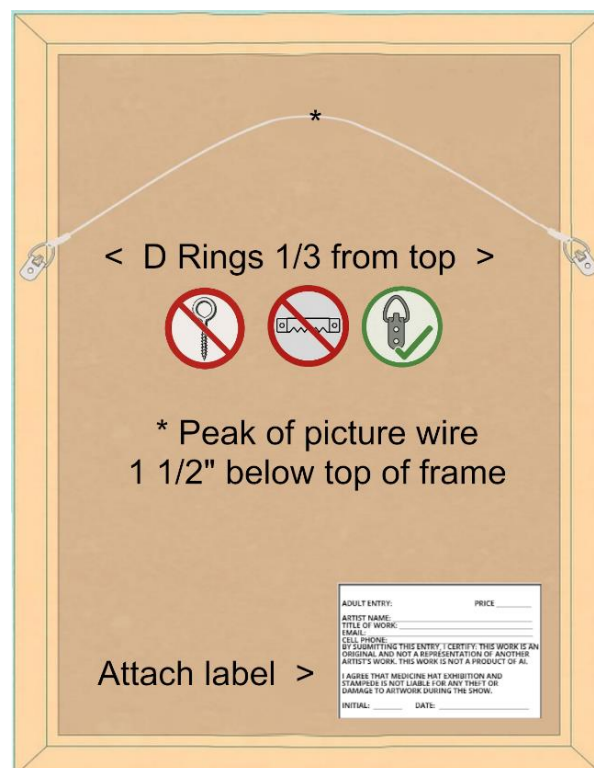


Submitting Your Art Entry

**Valid entries must comply with the following criteria.
Entries which do not qualify may be entered in the Better
Living Exhibition.**

Adult Entries: 3-D, 2-D entries, paintings, drawings and photographs:

1. **All work must be original work.** Any artwork that is a representation or reproduction of another artist's work will not be accepted.
2. Work cannot have been previously shown in the MHES Visual Arts show.
3. Work must be framed and wired, with the peak of the wire 1.5" from the top of the frame and use D-rings for hanging. No eye screws, eyelets, or other protruding hardware which could scratch the gallery wall. Entries which are not prepared in this way will not be accepted.





4. Gallery-style canvases must be a minimum of 1 inch deep and canvases must be finished on all sides.
5. Exhibitors may enter four entries ~ in total ~ in any category, with a maximum of four (4) entries per exhibitor.
6. Each artwork must have a label attached that includes the following information:
Artist's name ~ Address ~ Email Address ~ Cell phone number ~ Sale price (if applicable) ***Printable labels can be found in the physical pamphlet or online.***
7. Entries for this exhibition are not juried, but the Visual Arts Committee reserves the right to decline an entry if the art does not conform to the guidelines above, or is deemed inappropriate for the ages of the audience of this art show.
8. The Medicine Hat Exhibition & Stampede will not be liable for any theft or damage to artwork.
9. Artworks may be listed for sale but must remain on display until the exhibition concludes. Interested buyers are welcome to express their interest; however, all transactions must be handled directly between the artist and the buyer. Purchased pieces can only be collected ***after*** the show has ended.
10. If you are unable to pick up your art at the specified time on the entry pamphlet, arrange to have someone pick it up for you. The person picking it up must have the entry tags given at intake. The Visual Arts Show & Sale and the Medicine Hat Exhibition and Stampede are expressly not responsible for artwork not picked up on the pickup date.

Children's Art: 3-D, 2-D entries, paintings, drawings and photographs must:

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- Be mounted on construction paper, foam core, or framed.
- Labeled (see below for label information)
- Children's work must be *original and completed entirely by the child* to qualify. (We'd rather see an imperfect child's work than perfect adult-influenced work)
- Each child is limited to three (3) entries.
- Have the *Children's art label attached to the back of the art using glue*
